

## HOW TO SAFELY TRANSPORT GREENWARE

- Use a shallow box or tray to transport work
- Its best to transfer work when it is still leather hard, or a hard leather hard. If something breaks it is easier to repair in this stage and is also less fragile than bone dry pottery.
- Wrap each piece individually with bubble wrap, cloth, layers of dry cleaning plastic or newspaper.
- Make sure to pack the box/tray so there is no wiggle room. When pieces wiggle around they are more likely to break.
- Think about making "bumpers" for the side of the box/tray out of a soft material.
- Be sure not to layer work. Put work in the box/tray in a single layer.
- Place your box/tray on the floor or your car so it won't fall off the seat if you stop suddenly. Drive safely to the studio ( this you should always do)
